

Audio Feedback in Turnitin

An introduction to the voice comments feature in Turnitin

This feature allows you to leave audio feedback for students when you are marking their work.

This can be a quick and effective way to deliver personal feedback that enables students to understand their marks and also how they can improve on future work.

When viewing a student assignment in Turnitin the voice comments recorder can be accessed via the feedback summary icon.

You can record a comment of up to 3 minutes long.

To start recording press the record button and you will see the audio level indicator moving whilst you are recording you can move around the assignment with the scroll bar.

You can also look at your rubric whilst discussing it.

You can press pause at any time if you want to stop and consider what to say next.

After you have recorded your comment click the stop button.

You can play your comment back to see if you are happy with it.

If you are happy then click save.

Otherwise you can click the dust bin icon to discard it and then re-record.

When the student views their assignment in Turnitin they will see the playback section as the lecturer does but without the discard option.
